Deed, 22 August 1804, for two lots in Stevensburg, Culpeper County, from Joshua Woodrow and Nancy Woodrow to Charles Waugh.

Power of attorney, 25 October 1837, from John H. Eustace and George W. Payne to Samuel Downing, Jr., to collect rents in Culpeper County.
