Historical Information

Nelson County was formed in 1807 from Amherst County. The county was named for Thomas Nelson, Jr., governor of Virginia from June to November 1781.

Scope and Content

Nelson County (Va.) Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery Records, 1831-1851 , consist of court records related to finance as well as a writ. These records consist of Chancery Fee Books, Law Fee books, a fee book and a writ of summons.

A fee book is a volume showing the date of a duty performed by the clerk, the name of the person paying the fees, and the amount. It includes fees charged attorneys, cash accounts, and the clerk's fees in common law and chancery suits.
