VASILC promotes effective policies, programs and activities that maximize independence for Virginian's with disabilities by: developing, monitoring and reviewing the State Plan for Independent Living; supporting and expanding the state network of Centers for Independent Living; creating a culture for full integration and independence; advocating systems change for full access and equality in community life; educating policy makers and stakeholders about the importance of independent living; and developing a strategy for collaboration among stateholders in the disability community.
