Biographical Note

W. H. Auden (1907-1973) was an British-American poet. Auden is seen by some as one of the greatest writers of the 20th century. His poetry became widely known after his death, because of the adaptations to the screen of some of his works, such as "Funeral Blues" and "Four Weddings and a Funeral".

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of a letter written by W. H. Auden on January 9, 1938, from Brussels, Belgium, to "Geoffrey." Auden requests a copy of a sonnet "The Economic Man," which he submitted to *New Verse*, possibly in May 1936. Auden states that he needs the sonnet to complete another sonnet sequence he was writing at the time.

Separated Materials

Books by W. H. Auden were separated to the Rare Book Collection and the Newman Library collection.
