Wilse Frazier was born an enslaved person around 1840 and worked for the majority of the later years of his life on the former plantation "The Woodlands" near Clopper, Maryland. Frazier lived to the age of 110, passing away around 1949.

Robert Schmidt Fulghum is a retired professor of Microbiology and Medicine at Eastern Carolina University in Greenville, North Carolina. Fulghum and his cousin Helen Caulfield Madine Gregory authored the memoir.
