Biographical Note

Lucie Ligon Gibboney (1917-2007) was born on April 3, 1917, to Jacob Haller and Lucie (Ligon) Gibboney in South Carolina. In Monroe, West Virginia, in 1936, she married James Montgomery Graham, Jr. (1916-1976), who graduated from Virginia Agriculture and Mechanical College and Polytechnic Institute in 1938. They had at least two children, Caroline R. and David H. James worked as a draftsman and later as a mechanical engineer for the federal government, while Lucie worked as a homemaker.

After her first husband's death, Lucie married widower Charles Newell Sanders (1914-1990) on June 16, 1979, in Wytheville, Virginia.

All three are buried in Graham Cemetery in Grahams Forge, Wythe County, Virginia.
