In 1959, she enrolled as a student at then-Longwood College and graduated in 1962 with a bachelor's degree. While a student at Longwood, Pearce served as circulation manager of The Colonnade (student magazine) and was a member of the Student Education Association, Longwood Players, and the Wesley Foundation.
