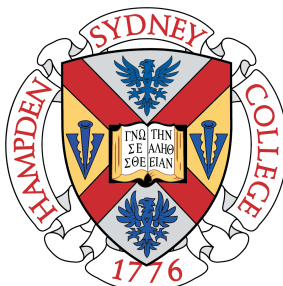

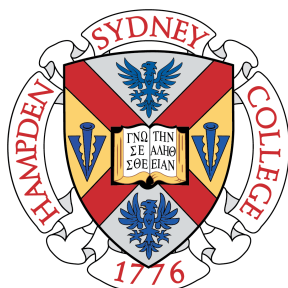

The Young Republican Federation of Virginia is a Republican organization for young Republicans between the ages of 18 and 40 that was established in 1936. According to their website, they are "a political grassroots organization comprised of individual YRs chapters that lead recruitment and volunteer efforts across the Commonwealth on behalf of Republican candidates." In December 1962, Hampden-Sydney College's Young Republican Club became a duly authorized member of the YRFV. Today, the Hampden-Sydney club is the College Republicans Society and is a chartered member of the College Republican Federation of Virginia, and is represented on the state executive board.
