Biographical Information

This collection contains an 1822 bond and court notice. The following individuals are represented in the bond and court notice:

Robert Coe (ca. 1789-1856) married Elizabeth Copeland (1794-1869) in 1813. He was a farmer and miller in Loudoun County, a veteran of the War of 1812 (357th Regiment of Virginia Militia), and a member of the Old School Baptist Church on Route 50 in Loudoun County. The Coes are buried at Mt. Zion Baptist Churchyard, Aldie, Virginia.

Philip Jones: could not be indentified from available records.

James Monroe (1758-1831) was the fifth president of the United States and for a number of years a resident of Loudoun County. His residence while in Loudoun County, Oak Hill, is a private home.

Moses "a negro boy the property of Charles Smith" held in the custody of Asa Rogers and B. Powell.

B[urr] Powell was High Sheriff (1820-1822) of Loudoun County and a farmer in Middleburg.

Asa Rogers (ca. 1802-unk) appears in the census records for 1830-1860. He was a farmer in Middleburg.
