[Acknowledges his friendship with Edward Clodd; lists works by Clodd which he owns; mentions that he is sending Morley a Loder portrait of Clodd which is available to purchasers of *Aftermath*; mentions Morley's editorials for the *Evening Ledger*, *Shandygaff*, *Verses*, *Child's Book of Lyrics*, and *Parnassus on Wheels*; mentions Edith Wharton, Hilaire Belloc and Stephen Butler Leacock; discusses edition of Joyce Kilmer's *Verses* published by Vaughan; mentions his acquisition of John Bell's *British Theatre* containing the autographs of Jane Sonntag; gives reasons for not writing his reminiscences as suggested by Morley and William Marion Reedy. ]
