Nicolai, a war hero; admires Nicolai because of his great personal courage; says he wrote several articles on the works of Nicolai, including *Biologie de la Guerre* and his memoirs; asks him to assist the American translator, Madame H. Van Brugh, in publishing the articles; discusses her talent; says he has shown Nicolai "Declarations de l'Independence d'Esprit" and approved it; asks him to sign a copy.] (In French with typed translation)
