Item 2: Invitation to Miss Sally McDowell, 1839 March29 An invitation to Miss Sally McDowell, near

Lexington, Virginia, to attend a party given at the Ball Tavern, [Richmond, Va.].

Item 3: Program of entertainment given in London by Mr. Peabody, 1851 July 4 Program of entertainment given in London by Mr. Peabody to the American minister and Mrs. Lawrence .

Item 4: Billing Account of Miss Lilly McDowell with John Miller, 1861-1865 Signed by Eliza McDowell Wolffe and Bernard L. Wolffe. Document Signed. Billing Accounty of Lilly McDowell with John Miller, primarily for board.
