Josef Roy Geiger was a Professor of Philosophy and Psychology; Associate Professor of Education, 1916-1919; and Professor of Philosophy and Psychology, 1919-1935, at the College of William & Mary.

The papers of Professor Josef Roy Geiger include lecture notes and proofs from his tenure at the College of William & Mary.
