Biographical / Historical

Lord John Berkeley, Baron of Stratton, was one of the Proprietors of the Northern Neck of Virginia as well as the Provinces of North and South Carolina. At the time of the signing of the document in this collection, he was Lord Lieutenant of Ireland under Charles II. He was a cousin of Norbonne Berkeley, sometime Governor of the Province of Virginia. Donated to the College of William & Mary by Henry J. Berkeley, Baltimore, in May 1926.
