There are four other charts: one on comparative statistics for State University, 1867-1892, with enrollment and graduates; one on comparative statistics for normal school, 1870-1892, with enrollment, graduates, and total number of graduates; one on effects of fertilizers at the Agricultural Experiment Station, 1892; and one on school statistics, 1892, with population of state, enumeration of youths, enrollment, average daily attendance number of school houses and teachers, value of school property, and permanent school fund.
