This collection includes three digital oral histories and associated transcripts for interviews with Terry Donk, Lucille and Robert Grimm (mother and son), and Paul Riggs, all employees of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad. The Donk interview is on video in six parts and features 1 hour 04 minutes 17 seconds of footage.
