Abstract

Minute book of the Farmington, West Virginia, town council from 1896 to 1898, as recorded by Lee Toothman, the town recorder. Minutes of town council meetings record information about the town's elected officials and issues facing the council. Topics include the town's laws and ordinances; buildings and grounds (including street lights, roads, maintenance); property issues; council expenditures; complaints; taxes; and license applications. Also includes an 1897 receipt from Lee Toothman to Joseph M. Fox for payment from Fox for damages to Toothman's property.
